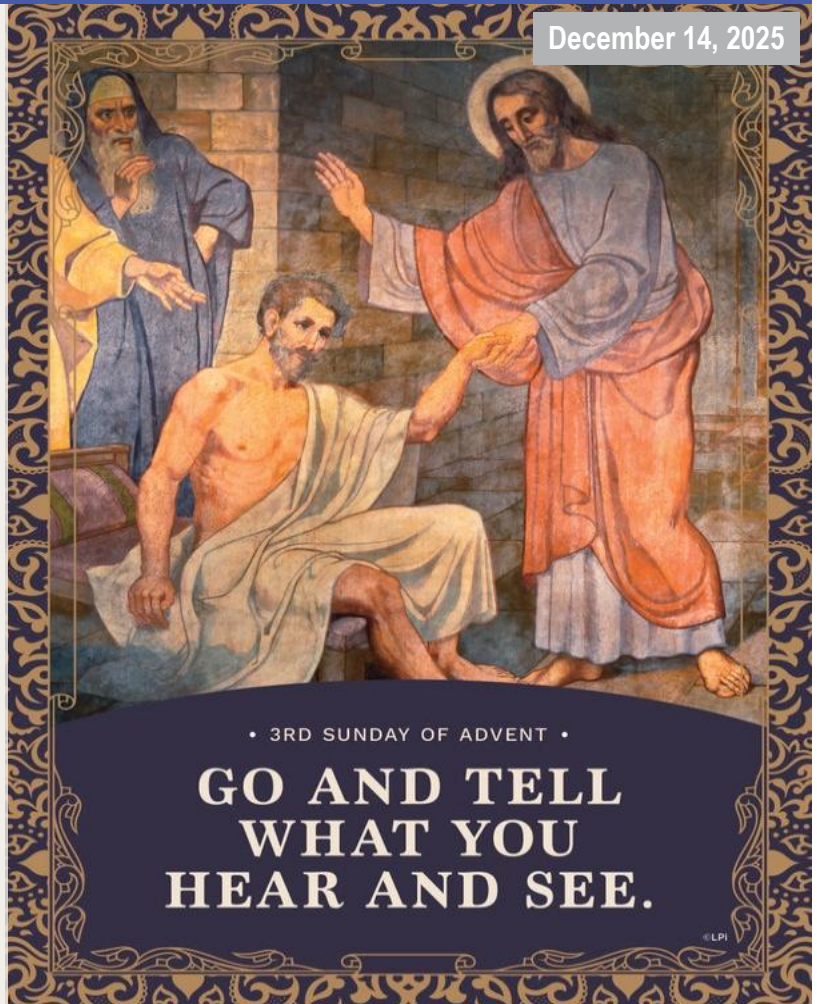

## ST. AGNES WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear St. Agnes,

I hope and pray that you have not only stayed safe amongst all of this snow, but that you have also let yourself enjoy it a little bit! No matter how old you are, you can still enjoy a snowball fight, making a snow man, or maybe even a little sled-riding!

Of course, I certainly understand why many folks don't look forward to snow. It is dangerous, messy, and ruins our plans to travel and gather. There is certainly a dark side to the snow fall. However, there is a bright side too that I don't want us to forget. Snow literally covers everything with a beautiful blanket of white to remind us of the purifying power of God's mercy. Remembering this can be quite helpful during the cold, winter months, especially for those who find it harder to be joyful during this season.

Consider, for example, how the sparkly white snow recalls the words of the Prophet Isaiah whom we have been listening to at Mass for two weeks now. "Come now," Isaiah says, "and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow" (Is 1:18). This is the promise that God made to humanity back during the time of the Babylonian Exile. No matter how bad our sins might seem to us, God can make us pure again without even the slightest stain remaining. He can make us "white as snow," and He does this through the power of His son, Jesus.

Snow is such a perfect image for what God has done for the whole! Like snow that easily covers an entire landscape, God covers the entire universe with His mercy! Regardless of one's faith background, or lack thereof, we all feel this reality when we wake up in the morning and look out at a snow-covered landscape for the first time. It touches something deep in our soul as if to say, "Yes, there is still hope, even in this dark and dreary world."

Inspired by the words of the Prophet Isaiah to God's people thousands of years ago, I too want to tell you, "Come now and let us reason together... though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow." This Wednesday, December 17th, we will have our Advent Penance service in the church starting right after our regularly scheduled 5:00PM Mass. There will be two or three other priests with me who will be available to hear Confessions so that our souls, "scarlet" with sin, can become "white as snow." You see, unlike the snowfall that covers anything and everything regardless of how we feel about it, God's mercy ONLY purifies our souls if we ask Him to, and there is no other place in the universe where His purifying mercy is poured out more fully than in the Confessional.

So, when you see the snow around this Winter, let it remind you of what God wants to do in our souls. Do not be afraid! "Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be a white as snow!"

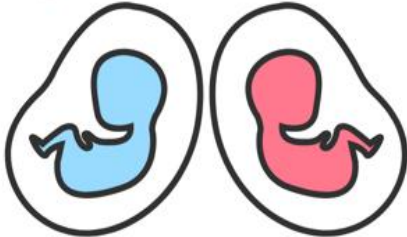

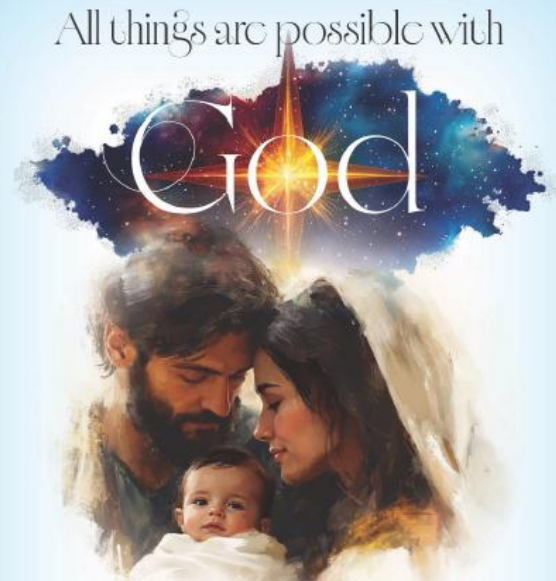

## ST. AGNES TO-DO LIST

*Perhaps you have wondered before, "What can I do to help around the church?" Well, take a gander! Here are some chores that need doing. Though I enjoy this kind of work, I can't say that I'll get to all of these things in a reasonable amount of time, so your help would be much appreciated! Just email me (pszabo@dwc.org) once you have taken care of something so I can remove it from the list!*

**Bulletin Advertisements:** We have a lot of room on the back of our bulletin for more advertisements. If you have a business that already supports the church, let us know so we can put your ad on the bulletin. If you have a business that is not directly supporting the church yet, or if you know of another business owner who would be interested in supporting the church, please let us know!

**Stick Collection:** Despite all of the tree trimming we have done this past year, the trees continue to drop branches all over the yard. There are some large enough to cause trouble for anyone helping mow the lawn. If you have about an hour a week to spare, consider taking a walk around the property here once a week with our wheelbarrow to pick up sticks that are laying in the yard. Let us know and we will tell you how to access the wheelbarrow.

**Painting Stairs by Old Convent:** The metal stairway leading up to the lower entrance into the old convent is in rough shape. You can tell that it was last painted black, but the green, and other colored paints from the past, are showing through. This will take some time to scrape and repaint. Let us know if you can help.

**Leaf Raking:** There are leaves continuing to cover the ground! We have an excellent crew of leaf rakers, but we can always use a few more good men, or women! Please send me an email if you would like to be added to our leaf raking crew!

**Phone Call Ministry:** We are looking for a volunteer to organize a phone call ministry to homebound parishioners. This person would help connect interested volunteers with homebound parishioners who would appreciate a phone call on a regular basis. This ministry would also reach out occasionally to people who are listed as our parishioners, but no longer attend Mass to see if they are in need of any help. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry.

**Rides to Mass Ministry:** We are looking for a volunteer to organize a group that is willing to help bring people to and from Mass that are unable to drive themselves, or who do not have a car. At times, these volunteers may also help people get to and from doctors appointments and other places that they cannot usually get to themselves. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry!

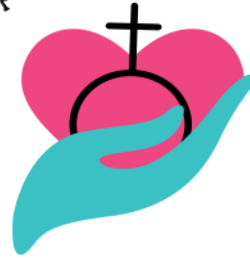

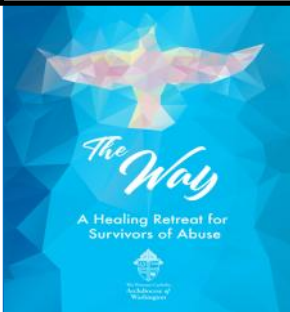
