ST. AGNES WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear St. Agnes,

I heard in a podcast this past week that the average person can only maintain about 150 friends at any given time in his or her life. A small number of these folks serve as our closest friends, and then the depth of relationship decreases from there.

I was struck by this idea because, as a priest who loves to be with his people, I often struggle with the fact that I never seem to have as much time as I would like to spend with my people. It always seems to me like I am just getting to know someone when it is time to move on to other duties and responsibilities with other families. It is almost like I already knew that I couldn't truly have more than 150 friends.

I share this now because I have also noticed that many of you share this struggle with me. Like me, many of you would like to spend more time together than I have to give, and this is a struggle that will only grow as the number of parishioners at St. Agnes increases.

Therefore, for all of our sakes, it is nice knowing that this is normal. The desire to spend more time together is actually a great gift, and the struggle associated with it is a natural consequence of enjoying this gift. The limitations of time and space to which we are all now confined in this life simply do not allow for the depth of relationship that our hearts long for.

This Advent season, we are invited to consider this longing that we all have in our hearts for relationship. We long for that day when we can finally share in the most intimate and perfect of relationships with God and one another in Heaven. Here on Earth, all of our relationships are limited and always leave our hearts yearning for more. Right now, we await with great expectation both the coming of Christmas when we can celebrate again the fact that Jesus is Emmanuel, God-with-us, and also the day when we will be with Him forever in Heaven, but that day has not yet come, and so this desire cannot yet be satisfied. This is just part of being human.

So, if you struggle like I do with the fact that we never seem to have enough time to get to know the people we love as well as we would like, then join me in giving thanks to God for this struggle. The fact that we struggle is a clear sign that we have been loved and that we have experienced the great joy of sharing this love with others. I am grateful for the love that you have all shared with me since my arrival here, and I look forward to enjoying your company for (please God) many more years to come even though it will never be as much as we would like. Thankfully, this is not a bad thing at all. In fact, this insatiable yearning might even keep our eyes fixed on God and the promise of eternal life if we let it. May God bless you all!

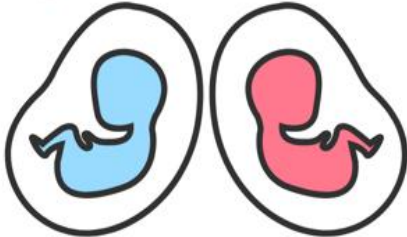

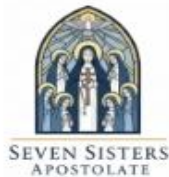

ST. AGNES TO-DO LIST

Perhaps you have wondered before, "What can I do to help around the church?" Well, take a gander! Here are some chores that need doing. Though I enjoy this kind of work, I can't say that I'll get to all of these things in a reasonable amount of time, so your help would be much appreciated! Just email me (pszabo@dwc.org) once you have taken care of something so I can remove it from the list!

Bulletin Advertisements: We have a lot of room on the back of our bulletin for more advertisements. If you have a business that already supports the church, let us know so we can put your ad on the bulletin. If you have a business that is not directly supporting the church yet, or if you know of another business owner who would be interested in supporting the church, please let us know!

Stick Collection: Despite all of the tree trimming we have done this past year, the trees continue to drop branches all over the yard. There are some large enough to cause trouble for anyone helping mow the lawn. If you have about an hour a week to spare, consider taking a walk around the property here once a week with our wheelbarrow to pick up sticks that are laying in the yard. Let us know and we will tell you how to access the wheelbarrow.

Garden Maintenance: The gardens around the church, rectory, and office are improving and are being prepared for the colder weather. If you have some time and would like to help prepare the gardens for the colder weather, let us know.

Plumbing: A number of faucets are leaking in one way or another, or doing things really old plumbing does. If you know how to do this sort of thing, let me know! We could use a hand replacing a number of old faucets!

Painting Stairs by Old Convent: The metal stairway leading up to the lower entrance into the old convent is in rough shape. You can tell that it was last painted black, but the green, and other colored paints from the past, are showing through. This will take some time to scrape and repaint. Let us know if you can help.

Leaf Raking: The leaves continue to fall! We have an excellent crew of leaf rakers, but we can always use a few more good men, or women! Please send me an email if you would like to be added to our leaf raking crew!

Phone Call Ministry: We are looking for a volunteer to organize a phone call ministry to homebound parishioners. This person would help connect interested volunteers with homebound parishioners who would appreciate a phone call on a regular basis. This ministry would also reach out occasionally to people who are listed as our parishioners, but no longer attend Mass to see if they are in need of any help. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry.

Rides to Mass Ministry: We are looking for a volunteer to organize a group that is willing to help bring people to and from Mass that are unable to drive themselves, or who do not have a car. At times, these volunteers may also help people get to and from doctors appointments and other places that they cannot usually get to themselves. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry!

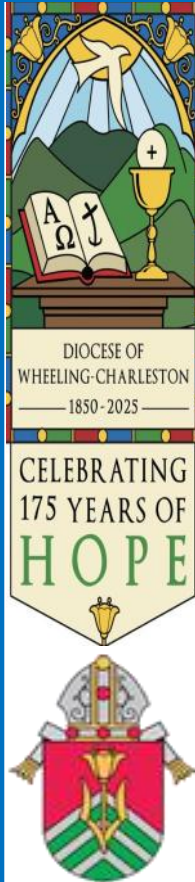

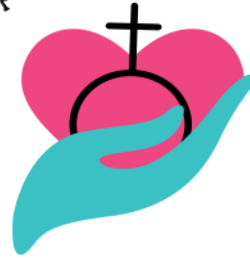

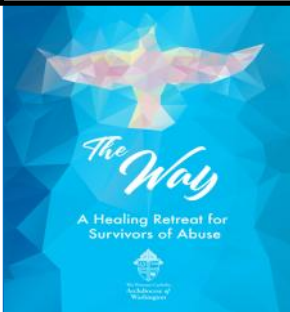
