## ST. AGNES WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear St. Agnes,

This past Sunday, we had our first Women's Night here at the parish with 15 ladies in attendance. It was a joy! We shared a meal, discussed a chapter from St. Francis De Sales' Introduction to the Devout Life, and then finished up with Night Prayer in the church.

Since we have been having Men's Nights for about a year and a half now, I immediately began noticing some funny differences between those evenings and our first Women's Night, and I think they are worth sharing. First of all, some of the women were attentive to the furniture arrangement in the rectory. As for our Men's Nights, I had roughly tossed some chairs around for people to sit on, but the ladies kindly suggested that we make a few changes. It was great! As a result of their help, we probably had one of the most comfortable gatherings in the house since I have arrived.

The next thing I noticed is that the only women who did not bring some kind of food along with them were the ones who did not know that it was an option to bring food. This is quite different from our Men's Nights where usually about half of the guys bring something with them. Therefore, we had a feast at our first Women's Night! I am so grateful for the generosity of the many ladies who provided for the delicious meal we had, and also inadvertently provided me with enough leftovers for a week!

After dinner, we usually transition pretty quickly at our Men's Nights from the meal to our spiritual discussion. Conversation amongst the guys typically dies down naturally by the end of the meal, and then everyone works quickly to get the dishes in the sink before moving into the living room. This past Sunday, however, I had to raise my voice considerably to let the ladies know that we were moving from dinner to our discussion. The ladies were having wonderful conversations all through dinner and it seems like they could have continued on for the rest of the evening! I was so happy to see everyone getting to know one another! This same thing carried into our spiritual discussion as well. The men are usually ready to wrap up our spiritual discussion after about an hour and a half, but I had to cut in to the discussion with the ladies to let everyone know that we were quickly approaching our proposed 8:30PM end time. What a blessing!

Finally, I was so humbled by the fact that the ladies literally left my rectory cleaner than it was before they arrived. Despite my pleading with them to allow me to do the dishes as a sign of my appreciation for all of the times that I have eaten in their homes and let them do my dishes, they proceeded not only to do all of the dishes, but also to clean the kitchen and move the furniture back to into a more normal arrangement. Thank you, ladies!

In any event, I hope that many more of you will take advantage of our newest Women's Ministry opportunity, especially if you are already enjoying the monthly Ladies Guild gatherings and/or the Women's Saint Study. Women of all ages are welcome regardless of what parish they attend, or even of their religious background. We had so much fun that anybody could enjoy it!

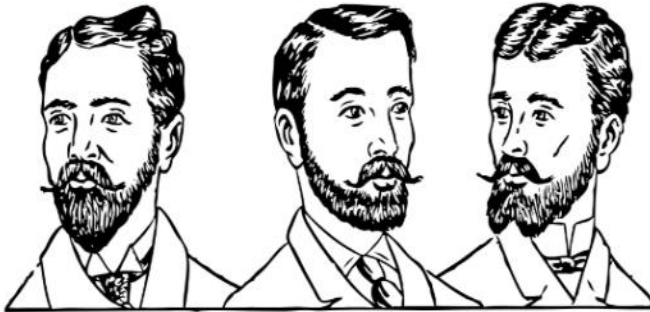

# DIOCESAN COMMUNICATION



Pope Leo XIV closed the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica, officially ending the Jubilee of Hope begun by Pope Francis in December 2024. After a brief moment of silent prayer, Leo shut the bronze doors, stressing that while the Holy Year has ended, the door of God's mercy remains open to the faithful.

Only the doors were closed publicly, while the traditional sealing will take place privately in the coming days.

## ST. AGNES TO-DO LIST

*Perhaps you have wondered before, "What can I do to help around the church?" Well, take a gander! Here are some chores that need doing. Though I enjoy this kind of work, I can't say that I'll get to all of these things in a reasonable amount of time, so your help would be much appreciated! Just email me ([pszabo@dwc.org](mailto:pszabo@dwc.org)) once you have taken care of something so I can remove it from the list!*

**Bulletin Advertisements:** We have a lot of room on the back of our bulletin for more advertisements. If you have a business that already supports the church, let us know so we can put your ad on the bulletin. If you have a business that is not directly supporting the church yet, or if you know of another business owner who would be interested in supporting the church, please let us know!

**Stick Collection:** Despite all of the tree trimming we have done this past year, the trees continue to drop branches all over the yard. There are some large enough to cause trouble for anyone helping mow the lawn. If you have about an hour a week to spare, consider taking a walk around the property here once a week with our wheelbarrow to pick up sticks that are laying in the yard. Let us know and we will tell you how to access the wheelbarrow.

**Painting Stairs by Old Convent:** The metal stairway leading up to the lower entrance into the old convent is in rough shape. You can tell that it was last painted black, but the green, and other colored paints from the past, are showing through. This will take some time to scrape and repaint. Let us know if you can help.

**Phone Call Ministry:** We are looking for a volunteer to organize a phone call ministry to homebound parishioners. This person would help connect interested volunteers with homebound parishioners who would appreciate a phone call on a regular basis. This ministry would also reach out occasionally to people who are listed as our parishioners, but no longer attend Mass to see if they are in need of any help. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry.

**Rides to Mass Ministry:** We are looking for a volunteer to organize a group that is willing to help bring people to and from Mass that are unable to drive themselves, or who do not have a car. At times, these volunteers may also help people get to and from doctors appointments and other places that they cannot usually get to themselves. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry!

**Cleaning the Church:** We are looking for some more volunteers, either individuals or families, who would be willing to help clean the church one week a month. Contact Donna Michael for more information at (304) 415-5581."

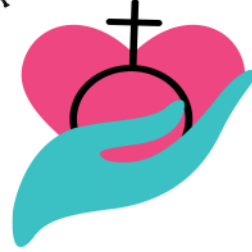

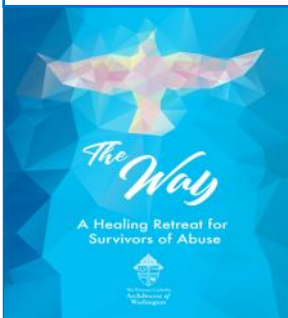
