ST. AGNES WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear St. Agnes,

I love YouTube! I use it all the time to learn about the faith, research how to fix my truck, figure out how to solve plumbing issues in the church, study Spanish, and sometimes just to watch funny videos for entertainment. We are alive at a great time in history! It is easier than ever to learn about the things that help us be better Christians!

However, I have learned that YouTube, like any tool, can also cause great harm to us. Sometimes we spend so much time watching entertaining videos that we fail to fulfill our duties and responsibilities. At other times, we end up stumbling across videos that show graphic and impure images that lead us to sin both in thought and deed. And, now for the first time ever, many people are being misled by phony videos of influential people that are generated by artificial intelligence (A.I.). Just the other day, someone shared a very convincing video of a famous Catholic cardinal. He claimed to have had a vision of Mary and was sharing the secrets with us. It was all made up and very disturbing.

Since I had watched some of this cardinal's legitimate videos, I could tell right away that something was off. His voice was a little different, the words and phrases he used were strange, and his appearance was too perfect. Sadly, the comment section was filled with praise and gratitude for this supposed "revelation." So many people are being misled because of how realistic A.I. generated videos are becoming.

Thankfully, it is not that hard to avoid YouTube channels that spread lies about the faith, or about any other topic for that matter. First of all, you need to have a strong spiritual life so that you can discern the truth. Praying daily, going to Mass at least on the weekends, and going to Confession monthly will keep your spiritual ears open so that you can hear that still, small voice of God guiding you towards the truth and away from falsehood.

Secondly, we need to stick to trusted YouTube Channels when studying the Faith. Trusted channels that have been around for a long time include, but are not limited to, EWTN, Catholic Answers, Catholic Productions, Theology of the Body Institute, Ascension Presents, Bishop Robert Barron, and so many others. If you ever have doubts, just email me and I'll let you know. A good rule of thumb is to only listen to channels that have been around for at least a year. A.I. generated channels are all very new and lack personality.

Finally, a word for parents. Please do not allow your children to have unrestricted access to YouTube or any online video service. Their underdeveloped brains and lack of experience make it impossible for them to distinguish between truth and falsehood. Kids under 18 should be limited to phones without internet access, or smartphones that have been restricted with a trusted app such as *SHIFT* which allows the phone to do everything a parent would like (calls, texts, email, GPS, tracking, apps for work & school, etc.) but nothing that will harm them (social media, impure content, distracting videos, etc.).

In the end, don't be afraid to use YouTube to study the faith! Just be careful. As Our Lord Himself said, "be wise as serpents and innocent as doves!" (Matt. 10:16).

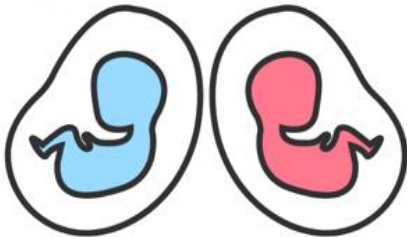

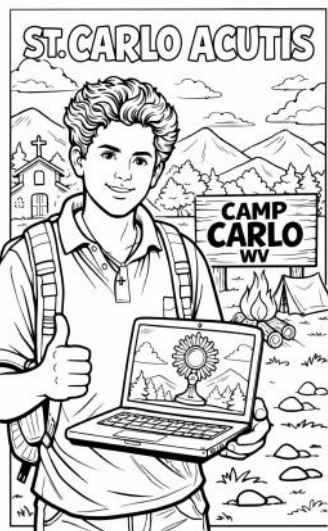

The Catholic Jubilee Year 2025 is coming to a close. It ran for just over a year, starting on Christmas Eve, December 24, 2024, and concludes on the Feast of the Epiphany, January 4, 2026, providing a period for spiritual renewal, forgiveness, and pilgrimage. Holy Doors are significant in Jubilee Years. They are special doors in major basilicas, such as St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City. The doors were opened at the beginning of the Jubilee Year and will be closed and sealed on the Feast of Epiphany until the next jubilee year,

There is still time to obtain plenary indulgences during the Jubilee Year by fulfilling specific spiritual acts. These are:

- Making a pilgrimage to a designated site.
- Participating in confession.
- Receiving the Eucharist.
- Praying for the pope's intentions.
- Being detached from all sin, even venial sin.

ST. AGNES TO-DO LIST

Perhaps you have wondered before, "What can I do to help around the church?" Well, take a gander! Here are some chores that need doing. Though I enjoy this kind of work, I can't say that I'll get to all of these things in a reasonable amount of time, so your help would be much appreciated! Bulletin Advertisements: We have a lot of room on the back of our bulletin for more advertisements. If you have a business that already supports the church, let us know so we can put your ad on the bulletin. If you have a business that is not directly supporting the church yet, or if you know of another business owner who would be interested in supporting the church, please let us know!

Stick Collection: Despite all of the tree trimming we have done this past year, the trees continue to drop branches all over the yard. There are some large enough to cause trouble for anyone helping mow the lawn. If you have about an hour a week to spare, consider taking a walk around the property here once a week with our wheelbarrow to pick up sticks that are laying in the yard. Let us know and we will tell you how to access the wheelbarrow.


Painting Stairs by Old Convent: The metal stairway leading up to the lower entrance into the old convent is in rough shape. You can tell that it was last painted black, but the green, and other colored paints from the past, are showing through. This will take some time to scrape and repaint. Let us know if you can help.

Phone Call Ministry: We are looking for a volunteer to organize a phone call ministry to homebound parishioners. This person would help connect interested volunteers with homebound parishioners who would appreciate a phone call on a regular basis. This ministry would also reach out occasionally to people who are listed as our parishioners, but no longer attend Mass to see if they are in need of any help. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry.

Rides to Mass Ministry: We are looking for a volunteer to organize a group that is willing to help bring people to and from Mass that are unable to drive themselves, or who do not have a car. At times, these volunteers may also help people get to and from doctors appointments and other places that they cannot usually get to themselves. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry!

Cleaning the Church: We are looking for some more volunteers, either individuals or families, who would be willing to help clean the church one week a month. Contact Donna Michael for more information at (304) 415-5581."

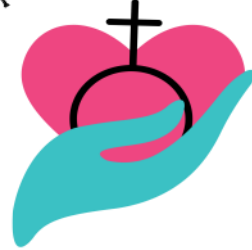

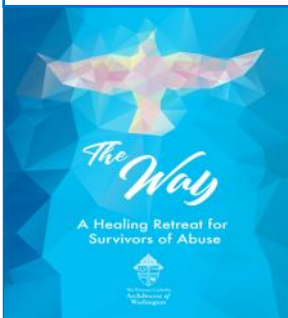
