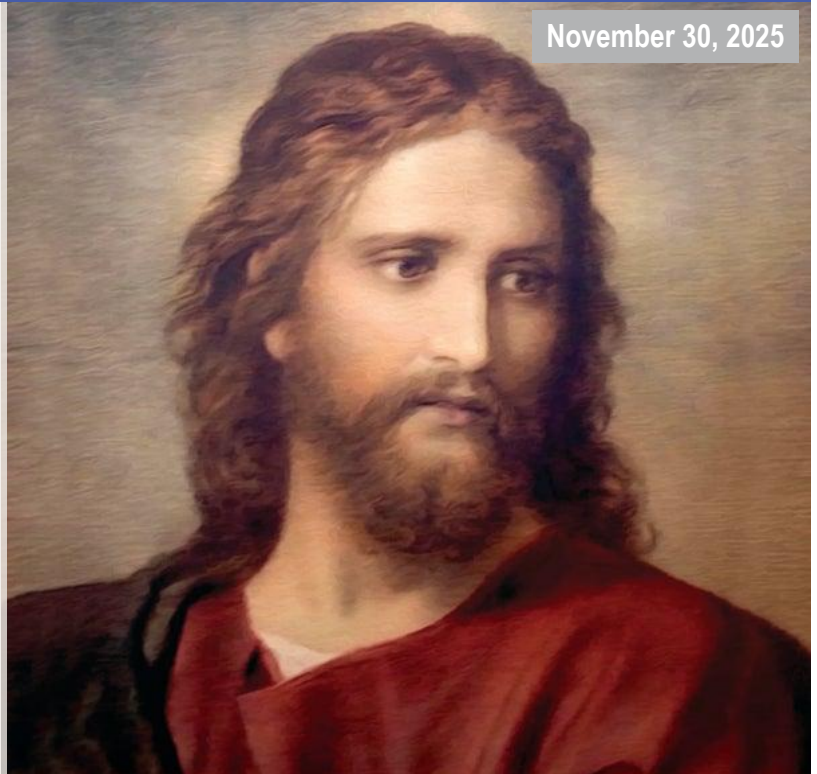

ST. AGNES WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear St. Agnes,

This past Monday, I learned that I need to start looking at inconveniences as opportunities. It all happened in Lowes while I was getting some supplies for a few projects I was going to work on that day.

Standing in the ladder aisle, I quickly realized that the monster, 32- foot ladder I needed to access the gutters and rooftops of the buildings on our property was so big that it would be a very bad idea for me to try and carry it up to the checkout myself. I could just see myself accidentally knocking someone out with it or demolishing one of the nice displays in the aisle.

So, after gathering the other items on my list, I went up to the cashier and asked her for some help. She said, “No problem, I’ll call the guy in that area and have him meet you there.”

Twenty minutes later...

The lady finally got ahold of someone in the Lawn and Garden section, at the other end of the store from the ladders. I slowly made my way back to the ladder aisle, frustrated, but glad that my wait was almost over. Then... I waited for another 5 or 10 minutes in the aisle.

When help arrived at last, I was pleasantly surprised. In fact, I don’t think I have ever met a Lowe’s employee who was so positive and excited to help. Even from a distance, he smiled and greeted me. Despite how grumpy I had become, my attitude changed quickly. He not only helped me get the ladder up to the front of the store, but then he opened a private check-out aisle for me.

As usual, I found a point in the conversation when I could ask this guy if he went to church anywhere around town. He told me that he was actually looking for a church and had not found one yet, and he wondered if it might be a sign from God that he met a minister that day. What a surprise! If I had not waited for help to arrive, or if I had stayed quiet and grumpy while I was being helped, I never would have met this gentleman, and maybe he would never have heard about our church! Maybe he was even here at Mass this weekend. If you are reading this, thank you again for your help last Monday brother!

So, the next time you are getting frustrated because of an inconvenience that takes up your time, ask God to help you see what He has planned, even if it is not what we had planned. So often we allow our frustrations to get the better of us so that we completely miss the surprises God has for us. Maybe He is slowing us down to save us from something? Maybe he is redirecting us so that we will meet someone who needs an invitation to church? Join me in trying to see inconveniences as opportunities. It will make everyone’s life better!

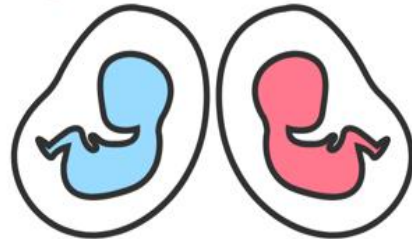

Perhaps you have wondered before, "What can I do to help around the church?" Well, take a gander! Here are some chores that need doing. Though I enjoy this kind of work, I can't say that I'll get to all of these things in a reasonable amount of time, so your help would be much appreciated! Just email me (pszabo@dwc.org) once you have taken care of something so I can remove it from the list!

Bulletin Advertisements: We have a lot of room on the back of our bulletin for more advertisements. If you have a business that already supports the church, let us know so we can put your ad on the bulletin. If you have a business that is not directly supporting the church yet, or if you know of another business owner who would be interested in supporting the church, please let us know!

Weed Trimming: If you know how to run a trimmer (or as we call them back home a "weed-wacker") we would love your help with the trimming around the church. We have a generous parishioner who is cutting the lawn each week, but it is just too much for him to also go around the buildings, fences, trees, etc. and trim along the edges of things. Let us know if you can help with this!

Stick Collection: Despite all of the tree trimming we have done this past year, the trees continue to drop branches all over the yard. There are some large enough to cause trouble for anyone helping mow the lawn. If you have about an hour a week to spare, consider taking a walk around the property here once a week with our wheelbarrow to pick up sticks that are laying in the yard. Let us know and we will tell you how to access the wheelbarrow.

Garden Maintenance: The gardens around the church, rectory, and office are improving and are being prepared for the colder weather. If you have some time and would like to help prepare the gardens for the colder weather, let us know.

Plumbing: A number of faucets are leaking in one way or another, or doing things really old plumbing does. If you know how to do this sort of thing, let me know! We could use a hand replacing a number of old faucets!

Painting Stairs by Old Convent: The metal stairway leading up to the lower entrance into the old convent is in rough shape. You can tell that it was last painted black, but the green, and other colored paints from the past, are showing through. This will take some time to scrape and repaint. Let us know if you can help.

Leaf Raking: The leaves continue to fall! We have an excellent crew of leaf rakers, but we can always use a few more good men, or women! Please send me an email if you would like to be added to our leaf raking crew!

Phone Call Ministry: We are looking for a volunteer to organize a phone call ministry to homebound parishioners. This person would help connect interested volunteers with homebound parishioners who would appreciate a phone call on a regular basis. This ministry would also reach out occasionally to people who are listed as our parishioners, but no longer attend Mass to see if they are in need of any help. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry.

Rides to Mass Ministry: We are looking for a volunteer to organize a group that is willing to help bring people to and from Mass that are unable to drive themselves, or who do not have a car. At times, these volunteers may also help people get to and from doctors appointments and other places that they cannot usually get to themselves. Let us know if you can help us start this ministry!

THE WAY
