ST. AGNES WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear St. Agnes Family,

In my bulletin article last week, I focused on how we should respond to violence in the world. Although we should pray for the victims and their families, I pointed out that it is even more important for us to pray for the perpetrators and their families if we ever hope to see this violent trend change. The Devil wants us to hate the perpetrators while simultaneously feeling good about ourselves because of the pious thoughts we have when we consider the plight of the victims, but this attitude will leave our world worse off because, at the end of the day, the Devil succeeded in bringing more hatred into the world than love.

This week, in light of the tragic killing of Mr. Charlie Kirk, it is time for us to consider briefly why this evil is happening and what we can do about it.

One of the biggest reasons behind the rise in violent crimes here in the U.S. is the secularization of our culture. Many people in this country live their lives without any visible connection to Jesus Christ and the truth He reveals to us. More and more people are growing up in families that did not attend church and, worst of all, this means that more and more people are unbaptized and vulnerable to the influence of Satan.

A quote famously attributed to G.K. Chesterton reads, “When men choose not to believe in God, they do not thereafter believe in nothing, they then become capable of believing in anything.” When our young people grow up in families that do not, or cannot, provide a solid grounding in truth based on the Gospel of Jesus Christ, they fall victim to the many secular ideologies that abound in their communities, especially online. Without Jesus and His Church to keep them on track, how can we wonder at a young man who freely and willingly chooses to kill an innocent person because he thinks that it will make our country better? This is not a random action by someone who believes in nothing, but rather the carefully calculated action of someone who is radically devoted to what amounts to a false religion.

So, what can we do to help stop, or at least slow down this violent trend? Take your kids to Mass and teach them the faith not only by your words, but even more importantly your actions. Go with them to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. Take your whole family to Confession and be the first one to go before your children. Talk about the Faith at home and be honest about your own struggles to live it out. Help your kids to become friends with other Catholic kids who will, in turn, help them remain strong in the truth.

As our community continues to grow, take advantage of the growing number of activities we have that will allow you and your children to form friendships that are rooted in more than just games or hobbies. Most importantly, don't let anything stand in the way of getting to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. By just giving God an hour or so a week in Sunday Mass and those few Holy Days during the year, we can be certain that we are doing our part to keep this violent trend from getting worse.

Perhaps you have wondered before, "What can I do to help around the church?" Well, take a gander! Here are some chores that need doing. Though I enjoy this kind of work, I can't say that I'll get to all of these things in a reasonable amount of time, so your help would be much appreciated! Bulletin Advertisements: We have a lot of room on the back of our bulletin for more advertisements. If you have a business that already supports the church, let us know so we can put your ad on the bulletin. If you have a business that is not directly supporting the church yet, or if you know of another business owner who would be interested in supporting the church, please let us know!

Weed Trimming: If you know how to run a trimmer (or as we call them back home a "weed-wacker") we would love your help with the trimming around the church. We have a generous parishioner who is cutting the lawn each week, but it is just too much for him to also go around the buildings, fences, trees, etc. and trim along the edges of things. Let us know if you can help with this!

Stick Collection: Despite all of the tree trimming we have done this past year, the trees continue to drop branches all over the yard. There are some large enough to cause trouble for anyone helping mow the lawn. If you have about an hour a week to spare, consider taking a walk around the property here once a week with our wheelbarrow to pick up sticks that are laying in the yard. Let us know and we will tell you how to access the wheelbarrow.

Garden Maintenance: The gardens around the church, rectory, and office are improving with the TLC being received. If you have a green thumb, or can at least distinguish between weeds and flowers, please feel free to come by for any amount of time to help maintain the many gardens that we have around the parish!

Plumbing: A number of faucets are leaking in one way or another, or doing things really old plumbing does. If you know how to do this sort of thing, let me know! We could use a hand replacing a number of old faucets!

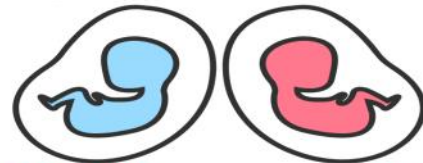

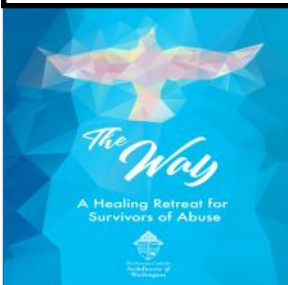
