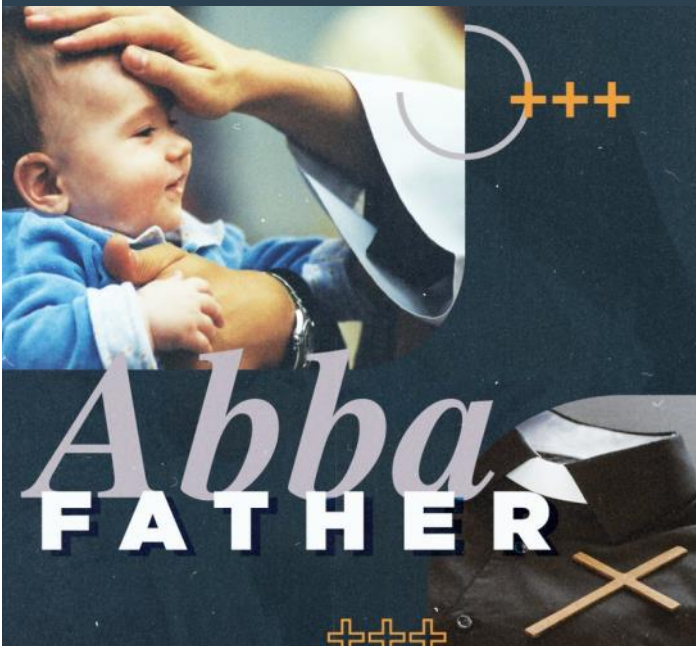

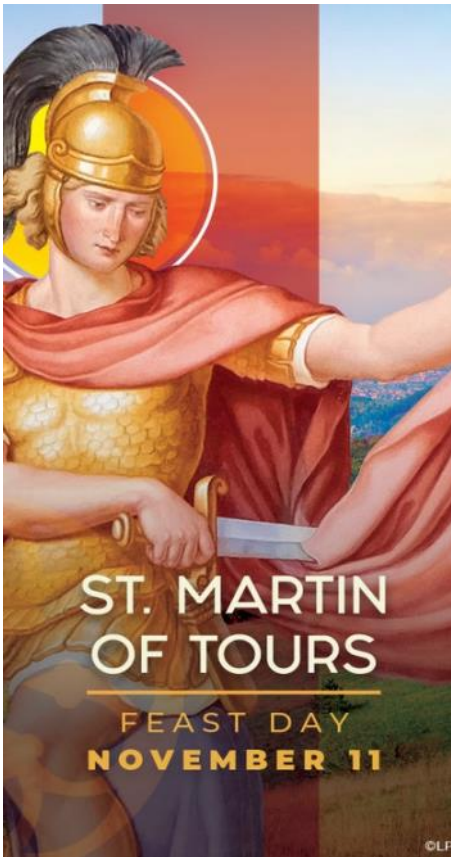

Saint Martin of Tours was born a pagan in what is now Hungary around 316, but he was raised in Italy where his father, a tribune, was posted. At 15 he was compelled to serve in the Roman military. He was baptized at 18. Only two years after his baptism, he was released from the military, he had refused his battle pay and to fight saying he was a soldier for Christ. He worked diligently against the Arian heresy, which denies the divinity of Jesus Christ, and established a community of hermits near Poitiers in 361, the first French monastery. In 371 he became bishop of Tour. Saint Martin died in Candes-Saint-Martin, Gaul in 397. He is notably one of the first saints who was not martyred. He is the patron saint of France.

CHAPTER ONE THE SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

Article 1 THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM.

VII. The Grace of Baptism.

Incorporated into the Church, the Body of Christ

1269 Having become a member of the Church, the person baptized belongs no longer to himself, but to him who died and rose for us.⁷⁵ From now on, he is called to be subject to others, to serve them in the communion of the Church, and to "obey and submit" to the Church's leaders,⁷⁶ holding them in respect and affection.⁷⁷ Just as Baptism is the source of responsibilities and duties, the baptized person also enjoys rights within the Church: to receive the sacraments, to be nourished with the Word of God and to be sustained by the other spiritual helps of the Church.⁷⁸

« *Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo* » (Lc 10, 27):
 « *promueve* » la vida

El Creador ha confiado la vida del hombre a su cuidado responsable, no para que disponga de ella de modo arbitrario, sino para que la custodie con sabiduría y la administre con amorosa fidelidad. El Dios de la Alianza ha confiado la vida de cada hombre a otro hombre hermano suyo, según la ley de la reciprocidad del dar y del recibir, del don de sí mismo y de la acogida del otro. En la plenitud de los tiempos, el Hijo de Dios, encarnándose y dando su vida por el hombre, ha demostrado a qué altura y profundidad puede llegar esta ley de la reciprocidad. Cristo, con el don de su Espíritu, da contenidos y significados nuevos a la ley de la reciprocidad, a la entrega del hombre al hombre. El Espíritu, que es artífice de comunión en el amor, crea entre los hombres una nueva fraternidad y solidaridad, reflejo verdadero del misterio de recíproca entrega y acogida propio de la Santísima Trinidad. El mismo Espíritu llega a ser la ley nueva, que da la fuerza a los creyentes y apela a su responsabilidad para vivir con reciprocidad el don de sí mismos y la acogida del otro, participando del amor mismo de Jesucristo según su medida.
